The Suburban line of RV water heaters includes high recovery gas and gas-electric models with sizes and features to match the requirements of almost any RV on the road. Porcelain-lined, high tensile steel tanks are pressure tested twice for assurance of tank integrity and a long life. Automatic models feature direct spark ignition with a remote switch for on/off control from inside the RV. The direct spark ignition circuit board is located on the rear of the unit away from exposure to the outside environment.



Cold hard facts... about hot water

1 Water tends to corrode all water heater tanks. A Suburban porcelain-lined tank will last longer than an aluminium tank.

Heating water accelerates the electrolytical action that attacks metal. Some RV water heaters have aluminium tanks with a coating to slow corrosive effects. But, the more water you heat, the faster you destroy an aluminium tank.

Suburban water heaters have porcelain-lined tanks, like the one in your home. The porcelain lining protects the steel tank from the effects of electrolysis which is the primary cause of corrosion. A replaceable anode rod provides corrosion "insurance" if a chip or crack occurs in a porcelain-lined tank. A Suburban water heater can save you hundreds of dollars on tank replacement alone.

2 You never know the condition of an aluminium tank until you find water on the floor. You can check a Suburban porcelain-lined tank when you drain it between trips.

To drain a Suburban tank, simply unscrew the replaceable anode rod. If the rod is mostly eaten away, put in a new one. For a minimal investment it'll keep your tank corrosion free for another year or two.

3 Some RV gas water heaters heat faster than others. Suburban models heat water fastest of all.

The more gas supplied to the burner, the faster water heats. Suburban's high input burners and super performance are standard on all models. Most competitive water heaters recover at a much lower rate.

ANODE ROD/DRAIN PLUG

This inexpensive anode rod absorbs all the corrosive action of hot water. You unscrew it to drain the tank. If the rod is mostly eaten away, simply replace it with a new one.
